

GLEWS⁺ TRIPARTITE PRIORITY DISEASES CRITERIA

July 2022

For each disease category a new specific criteria to post information have been drafted:

Group 1: Global tripartite priority diseases with high impact on animal and/or human health

1. *Active sharing of any relevant signals and information (documents) regarding the tripartite priority diseases.*
2. *Request of information for event verification when:*
 1. *First occurrence or recurrence of an event:*
 - a) *Unusual phenomenon for the area or season,*
 - b) *Event associated with an unknown hazard,*
 - c) *New host or new vector able to transmit disease;*
 2. *Emerging threat with significant human or animal mortality or morbidity;*
 3. *Potential for national, regional or global spread and/or potential impact on international travel or trade.*

Group 2: Diseases with high impact on human and low impact on animal health

1. *Sharing any relevant signals for information*
2. *Request of additional information/verification for potential high impact on human and animal health*
3. *Diseases with a potential bioterrorism use*

Group 3: Diseases with high impact on public health in outbreak situation

1. *Sharing signals of unusual/unexpected disease pattern (i.e. outbreaks, seasonal or geographical changes etc.)*
